

RESOLUTION 014-21



Authorizing the Executive Director to enter into a contract with Teltron Design Group for the purchase, installation, and one (1) year of service for a Security Camera System and expend an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00).

Staff has identified the need to replace the aging and inadequate camera systems at the SWACO facilities with modern enterprise grade systems. These enterprise camera systems will allow for greater visual support, ensuring optimum levels of safety, transparency, and efficiency in operations. Teltron Design Group ("Teltron") will design and install the new camera systems at five (5) SWACO facilities, including the Administrative Office Building (AOB), Fleet Garage, Landfill Scale House, Jackson Pike Transfer Station, and Morse Road Transfer Station. Additionally, this includes a one (1) year service contract on a time and materials basis to remedy any issues outside the product warranty.

Pursuant to SWACO's Amended Procurement Policy, Staff advertised a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for qualified enterprise grade security camera systems. Ten (10) qualified proposals were received and after a two (2) phase evaluation process, Teltron was deemed the best and most responsive.

Staff therefore recommends the Board authorize the Executive Director to enter into a contract with Teltron Design Group for the purchase, installation, and one (1) year of service for a Security Camera System and expend an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00).

Summary

Staff has identified the need to replace the aging and inadequate camera systems at SWACO facilities with modern enterprise grade systems. Teltron Design Group will design and install new camera systems at five (5) SWACO facilities and will provide services for one (1) year.

Authorizing the Executive Director to enter into a contract with Aptim Corp, dba Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC, for the 2021 Landfill Gas Collection and Control System construction at the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill and expend an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars (\$651,882.00).

SWACO is required to maintain an extensive gas collection and control system (GCCS) and related structures at the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill (FCSL). The GCCS is designed to control landfill gas migration, assist in odor management, and provide the landfill gas for the Aria Energy project. Routine operation and maintenance is critical to ensure continuity of service and prevent additional costs or regulatory fines associated with poor performance and unscheduled downtime. Updates to the current system at the FCSL are necessary, including the installation of new landfill gas collection wells, abandonment of existing gas collection wells, extension of air and force main lines, and all associated gas collection system modifications.

Pursuant to SWACO's Procurement Policy, Staff advertised a Request for Bid (RFB) for this project. Aptim Corp, dba Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure (Aptim), Inc., was deemed the lowest and best responsive bidder.

Staff therefore recommends the Board of Trustees authorize the Executive Director to enter into a contract with Aptim in order to complete the GCCS construction.

Summary

- This project consists of system updates to SWACO's gas collection and control system (GCCS) at the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill (FCSL).
- The updates will serve to fulfill SWACO's regulatory compliance requirements relating to the GCCS, but also relate to the increased production of landfill gas as supplied to the Aria energy project.
- The amount proposed herein includes a ten percent (10%) contingency in addition to the original bid.

Purpose & Goals

- This project supports the SWACO Mission of managing the waste stream with environmental stewardship through safe and effective utilization of the GCCS at the FCSL.

Process Used:

- State Bid Competitive Process Sole Source
- SWACO publicly advertised a Request for Bid and six (6) bids were received from the following firms: Landfill Drilling & Piping, Inc.; Blue Flame Crew LLC, American Environmental Group, Ltd., Tri Con Works, LLC, Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC, and Noble Environmental.
 - Aptim Corp, dba Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC was deemed the best and most responsive.
