RE: Vehicle Policy for Transfer Station Facilities

Dear SWACO Customer:

Please be advised that **effective immediately**, no small trucks, trailers, or box trucks will be able to utilize the Morse Road Eco-Station or Jackson Pike Transfer Station facility for the drop off of waste materials. Only registered refuse vehicles such as front loaders, rear loaders, side loaders, and roll off trucks will be permitted to use these facilities. Due to increased traffic at both facilities and safety concerns for both SWACO employees and customers, small trucks, trailers, and box trucks will be required to haul directly to the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill (FCSL) for disposal. The FCSL allows for more room to unload and maneuver safely, and SWACO Staff is available to help direct traffic and advise as to proper procedures. Please feel free at any time to ask SWACO Staff for assistance or directions, as we are committed to the safety of our employees and customers at all times, as well as the safe and effective operation of the landfill facility.
