This Addendum #1 is hereby incorporated into the Bid Documents. Any and all contrary or substitute statements, representations, or declarations encompassed within the previously issued Bid Documents are hereby superseded by this Addendum #1. Any and all additions or clarifications contained herein constitute supplemental information to be considered in addition to any previous information contained in the Bid Documents. This Addendum is being provided to all known interested Bidders who registered in accordance with the Legal Notice and Instructions to Bidders. A copy of Addendum #1 will also be included with all Bid Documents.

In addition, the Contractor shall provide open top roll-off containers of up to forty (40) yards capacity for Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials at no charge upon request of the City for three Household Hazardous Waste Collection events. The Contractor shall provide open top roll-off containers of up to thirty (30) yards capacity and Collection Services for solid waste and recyclable materials for six (6) additional special events per year at the discretion of the City. The Contractor shall provide open top roll-off containers of up to (30) yard capacity and Collection Services for minor remodeling of any Municipal Facility, up to 5 pulls per year. Additional pulls may be requested at the price, if any, indicated on the Bid Form.

Solid Waste Containers and Collection

The City shall provide each Residential Unit with a 96-gallon, 64-gallon, or 48-gallon Solid Waste collection Container. Residents will be able to select an appropriately sized Solid Waste container for their needs. Per month cost for all services will be based on the selected size of Solid Waste container. The Collection Contractor will only be required to collect material that has been placed in the City-provided Solid Waste container, with limited exceptions (“cart contents only”).

Recyclable Materials Containers and Collection

The City shall provide each Residential Unit with a 65-gallon wheeled, blue-colored, Recyclable Materials collection container. The Collection Contractor will only be required to collect material that has been placed in the City-provided Recyclable Materials cart, with limited exceptions (“cart contents only”).

Yard Waste Containers and Collection

The Collection Contractor must also provide weekly Yard Waste collection, for which Residents must provide their own containers.

Bulk Collection

The Collection Contractor shall collect 1 Bulk item per Residential Unit, on the regularly scheduled collection day from the usual point of pickup at a Residential Unit, without advance notice from the resident.

Bid Entry Table

Bidders shall provide a price for service described above by entering figure A in the bid entry table below, which is the bid price for provision of service for a Residential Unit that uses a 96-gallon solid waste cart. The prices for service for Residential Units that use the 64- and 48-gallon Solid Waste cart sizes will be calculated using the formula in the Bid Entry Table (subtracting \$1.25 per month for using a 64-gallon cart and subtracting \$2.50 per month for Residential Units using a 48-gallon cart).

The City of Bexley requests an **optional** add-on price to provide weekly curbside Food Waste collection to a minimum of 1,200 Residential Units in the City, but up to all 4,300 residents. This bid shall be open to any Collection Contractor submitting a bid for Collection Services, as well as any specialty food waste collection company electing to bid on this service.

Curbside Food Waste collection services in Bexley began in 2019 and there are currently approximately 1,700 homes participating in the program. The new contract for Food Waste collection services shall begin January 1, 2027. The program will continue to be available to all residents in the City of Bexley. The City already has a registration process for any interested residents and will notify the selected Food Waste Collection Contractor of the addresses that have registered to receive the service. Additional residents shall be able to enter into the program once per month. Should residents later opt-in or opt-out of the service after the start of the program, the City shall provide prompt notification to the selected Food Waste Collection Contractor.

Food Waste Collection Containers

The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall provide each participating Residential Unit with one (1) five- gallon lidded collection container and a second five-gallon lidded collection container at the request of any resident. The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall also distribute replacement liners to participating residents during weekly collection. Residents currently participating in the program will continue to use the collection container that they already have until it needs to be replaced. The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall replace lost or damaged collection containers at the request of any Resident, one time at no charge, and \$5.99 per container (bucket and lid) thereafter. All buckets distributed as part of the program shall become the exclusive property of the City of Bexley.

Weekly Curbside Collection

The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall provide regular weekly curbside collection of Food Waste from each Residential Unit located within the City that has registered for Food Waste collection service. All Food Waste generated at each Residential Unit and placed in the designated container shall be collected by the Food Waste Collection Contractor. The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall collect, transport and deliver all Food Waste to the Food Waste Processing facility identified with the bid price.

Collection at City Facilities

The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall provide up to six (6), 65-gallon wheeled collection containers at City Hall for collection of Food Waste. These containers shall be collected weekly at no charge. (the City currently has four (4) 65-gallon toters at City Hall for Food Waste drop-offs and may increase that to six (6) toters during the duration of this contract, at no additional charge). The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall collect all Food Waste deposited in the collection containers on the day of the collection. If additional collections are necessary, the Food Waste Collection Contractor shall collect such containers as requested by the City, at no additional charge, provided that City requests for additional collection do not exceed (4) calls in a calendar month. Any additional locations, and any additional pulls at the City Hall location, shall be at the additional charges identified below.

Pumpkin Collection

The Collection Contractor shall collect pumpkins for two weeks in the fall from City Hall toters (residents drop off pumpkins at City Hall). In addition, the Collection Contractor shall coordinate with the City to schedule a curbside collection of pumpkins annually between Thanksgiving and December 7th.

Commercial Establishments, Religious Establishments and Multi-Family Homes

The Collection Contractor shall offer the same rate for weekly collection to Bexley based businesses, Religious Establishments and multi-family homes within the City of Bexley as is provided below for additional City of Bexley facilities, and shall separately bill those properties directly

Compost “Give Back” Program

The City currently has 300 residents who participate in the weekly Food Waste Collection and who also receive compost as part of a “give back” program. Under this program residents who are participating in weekly collection also receive a certain amount of finished product each year free of charge. Interested bidders are encouraged to propose a “give back” program.

Billing and City Payment

The Food Waste Collection Contractor shall bill the City directly for Food Waste Collection Services, within ten (10) days following the end of the month. The City shall pay the Food Waste Collection Contractor on or before the thirtieth (30th) day following the end of the month. The City shall bill the residents for the service.

In the event that a specialty Food Waste collection company is selected to provide curbside Food Waste Collection, the specialty Food Waste Collection Contractor and the City shall enter into a contract setting forth the rights and obligations of each.
