

Request for Proposals to Provide Household Hazardous Waste Collection and Processing Services

Posted: January 9, 2026

This Addendum No. 1 shall be considered part of the Request for Proposals to Provide Household Hazardous Waste and is intended to correct, change, and/or add to the documents described below. Please make sure to complete the *Addenda Acknowledgement* form included in the *Required Forms* (Exhibit B).

Listed below are questions received with answers from SWACO:

***Question #1:** The RFP indicates that for Mobile HHW Collection Events the Successful Proposer will be responsible for providing "all necessary equipment. . ." for the event. What about roll-off containers to dispose of trash collected during the event (such as containers that have been emptied of used motor oil, etc.) and roll-off containers to recycle cardboard boxes? Would the Successful Proposer be responsible for providing these as well?*

Answer: Section II, paragraph J(2), of the RFP Documents states, "Project or Services means providing 'all necessary labor, equipment...' ...at each location as identified in the Scope of Services." The Scope of Services, Exhibit A, identifies and describes the details of the work accordingly.

As clarification to the RFP Documents, the community would be responsible for providing roll-off containers. Furthermore, Successful Proposer will be responsible for the following:

- a) Reviewing the proposed mobile event site location, if necessary, and provide input as to its suitability for a mobile event, including recommending preferred site layout, traffic flow, and other logistical issues. (Most events occur at the same location year after year, so this is typically not necessary).
- b) Coordinating and communicating with SWACO and the local community once an event date and location has been established. The collection dates will typically be established no later than January of a given year for mobile events that are taking place during that year. Most events are held yearly on a similar day, year after year (e.g., the last Saturday of September).
- c) Providing all necessary equipment, including trucks, trailers, forklifts, pallet jacks, pallets, gaylords, drums, other containers, safety and cleanup materials, with the exception of roll-off containers for trash and recycling.
- d) Provide all staffing necessary to conduct the event.
The local community will typically provide roll-off containers for collecting trash and recycling cardboard, signage, traffic cones, and volunteers to help direct traffic and count cars.
- e) Collecting materials from vehicles participating in the event.

- f) Containerizing and transferring all material to an appropriate facility for processing in compliance with all environmental and transportation requirements.
- g) Performing complete site clean-up after the event.
- h) Reporting to the Community and SWACO the amount and types of material collected during the event.

Question #2: I would like a list of vendors that have downloaded this RFP.

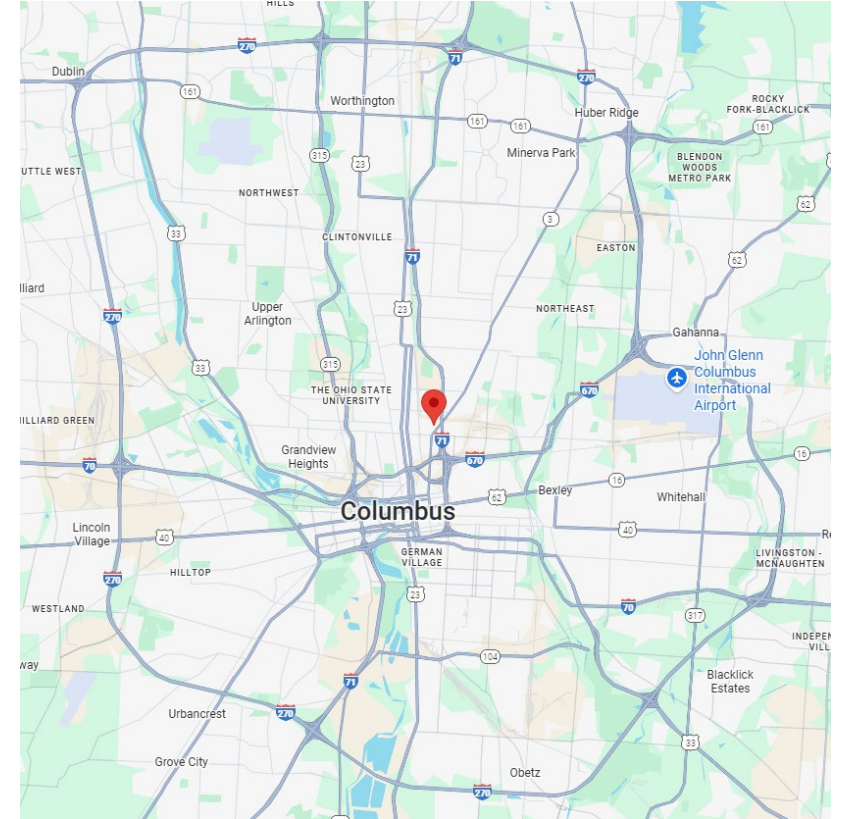
# SWACO's Current HHW Program

- 3 – 4 Mobile Events



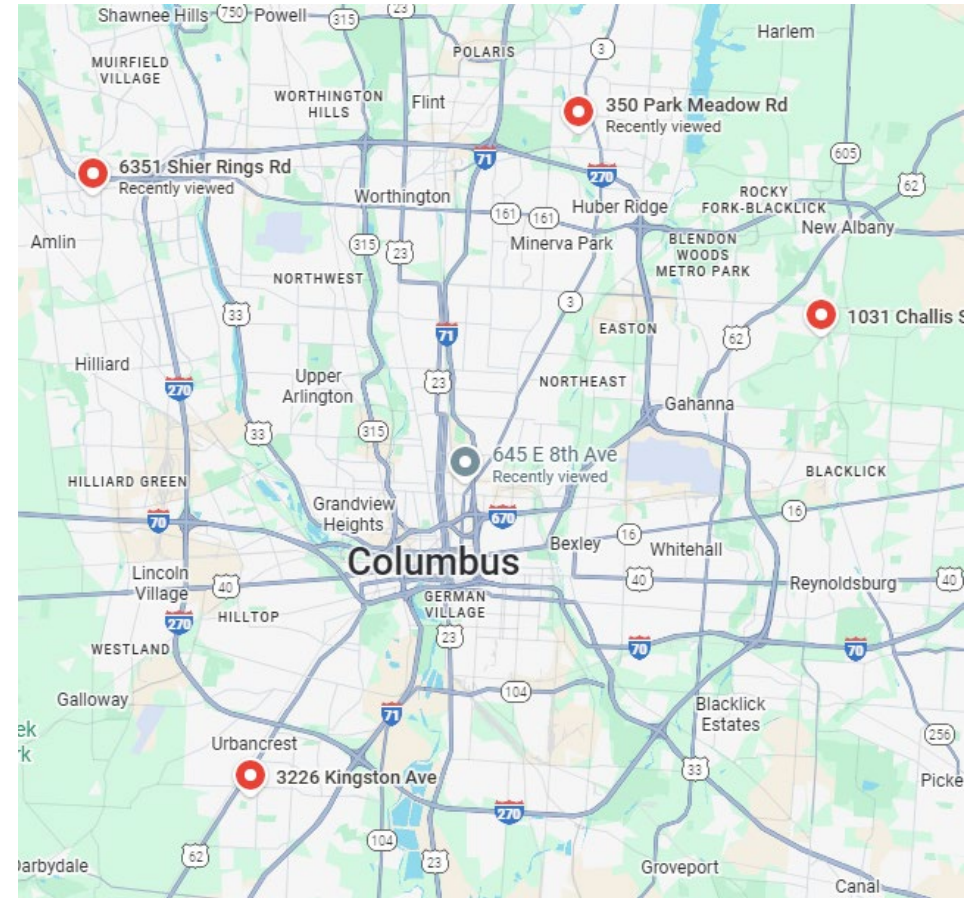
# SWACO's HHW Program

- Permanent Location
  - Centrally Located
    - 645 E. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave, Columbus OH 43210
  - Open 9 – 5, M-F
  - Open 9 – 2 First Saturday of the Month
- Services about 25- 65 cars/day
- Receives about 550,00 – 700,000 lbs./yr
- SWACO does not own or lease the property



# SWACO's HHW Program

- Mobile Events
  - 3-4 yr
    - NW, NE, SW areas
  - 500 – 1,000 cars
  - 25,000 – 45,000 lbs
- Number & Location of Events Determined by SWACO in partnership w/ Local Community

# Components of the RFP

- Permanent Location
- Mobile Events

# RFP Option 1: Permanent Location

- Propose permanent location
  - Location, facility details, ownership, limitations
- Identification of authorizations to conduct HHW services at the location
  - Timeline to get authorizations, if applicable
- Planned site improvements (and timeline)
- Safety measures
- Collection Method
- Material types & recycled, disposed, other processing
- Documentation/monthly reporting
- Fee structure
- Cost Savings measures

# Option 2 – Mobile Collection Events

- SWACO will work w/ Community & Contractor to schedule events
- Contract responsible for all on-site operation activities during event
  - Personnel, equipment, collection from vehicles, site clean-up
- Describe typical equipment used
- Describe size, responsibilities, and qualifications of on-site team
- Materials collected, recycled, disposed, other processing
- Where will material be processed
- Reporting
- Fee structure

# Option 3 – Hub & Spoke Local Collection

- Not a current program, but planned in future w/ 1-4 communities
- Local community collection
- Limited subset of HHW, to be determined by community
  - (e.g. batteries, CFLs, oil-based paint, auto fluids)
- Contracted vendor would:
  - Provide collection containers to community (drums, gaylords, pallets, etc.)
  - Train local community on proper handling
  - Accept or collect materials from community
  - Process materials
  - Ongoing technical support to community

# Option 3 – Hub & Spoke Local Collection

- Experience transporting and processing material
- Types of equipment provided to community
- Qualification for training community. In-house?
- Material types, recycled, disposed, other method
- Fee structure
