

Request for Proposals for the Fabrication and Installation of Exterior Graphic Trailer Wraps

Posted: June 11, 2026

This Addendum No. 2 shall be considered part of the RFP for the Fabrication and Installation of Exterior Graphic Trailer Wraps and is intended to correct, change, and/or add to the documents as described below. Please make sure to complete the *Addenda Acknowledgement* form included in the *Required Forms* (Exhibit B).

Listed below are questions received with answers from SWACO:

Question #16: *For the two trailer locations (4109 London-Groveport Road and 4313 Jackson Pike, Grove City, Ohio 43123) are the on-site installation bays both indoor?*

Answer: Yes.

Question #17: *The whole of the front (8.5 x 9 feet) is to be covered with vinyl?*

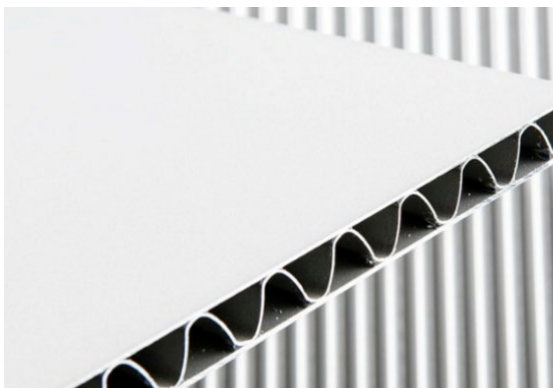
Answer: Yes, the entire front panel will be covered with vinyl. The trailer sides will receive a partial wrap, while the rear portion of the trailer will remain uncovered, leaving the aluminum surface exposed. The SWACO logo will be applied to the exposed aluminum area on the rear section of the trailer.

Question #18: *Please confirm all vinyl material is regular opaque, not reflective, for night safety?*

Answer: Correct. All vinyl included in this wrap design is standard opaque vinyl. No reflective vinyl or reflective materials are included as part of the trailer wrap.

Question #19: *What is the level / percentage of corrugation on the surface?*

Answer: The exterior surface of the trailer panels is smooth, polished aluminum and does not have exposed corrugations that would affect vinyl application. The term "corrugation" refers to the internal structure of the aluminum panel, which provides strength and rigidity. The primary surface obstructions that the vinyl installer will encounter are the weld seams where individual panels are joined together to form the trailer walls. The vinyl wrap will need to be applied over these welded joints.



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Question #20: What is your timeline for completing the (13) trailers in 2026?

Answer: SWACO expects to take delivery of the thirteen (13) trailers in early July 2026. The trailers are anticipated to be available for the wrap installation project during the week of July 20, 2026, or the week of July 27, 2026. The selected vendor should plan accordingly based on trailer availability during that timeframe.

Question #21: How many will be available to wrap at a time?

Answer: SWACO has designated bay space available to accommodate one trailer at a time if the wrap installation is performed at a SWACO facility. Alternatively, SWACO is willing to deliver up to two (2) trailers at a time to a vendor's facility located within a 20-mile radius of SWACO's Operations Facility at 4109 London Groveport Road, Grove City, Ohio, provided the vendor has the capacity to perform installation work on two or more trailers simultaneously. Vendors should indicate their preferred installation approach and production capacity in their proposal.

Question #22: Will the rear and front portions of the box be fully wrapped too?

Answer: The front of each trailer will be fully wrapped with vinyl, and the wrap design will extend from the front panel onto the forward portion of both trailer sides. The rear portion of the trailer on the sides will have just a SWACO logo applied directly to the aluminum and there will not be a wrap on the back portion of the trailer where this SWACO logo will be applied. No vinyl wrap will be applied to the rear door of the trailer.

Question #23: Are the trailers in use before being wrapped?

Answer: No, the trailers are brand new and have not been placed into service. The wrap installation will be performed before the trailers begin operational use.

The deadline for questions relating to this RFP is 4:00 p.m., June 12, 2026.

Proposals are due no later than 1:30 p.m., June 16, 2026.
