

Request for Proposals to Provide Clean Hard Fill at FCSL

This Addendum No. 1 shall be considered part of the to RFP to Provide Clean Hard Fill at the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill and is intended to correct, change, and/or add to the documents as described below. Please make sure to complete the *Addenda Acknowledgement* form included in the *Required Forms* (Exhibit B).

Listed below are questions received with answers from SWACO:

Question #1: *I have reviewed the RFP located on your website but was unable to locate the drawings for this project. Are drawings available? If so, how/where do I access them?*

Answer: Drawings are not available for this project. The project was reviewed in detail at the pre-proposal meeting and site visits are available and encouraged.

Question #2: *Would it be possible to get clarification on the provided documentation? My understanding is that for this particular project as part of the bid, SWACO expects payment compensation for the usage area of the proposed fill utilized for the purposes of this project. Please advise or clarify.*

Answer: Reference in Section III(B)(6) of the RFP. Proposals are to include a fee structure to be paid to SWACO for the use of the East Borrow Pit for clean hard fill. Please provide the preferable method (per CY, per ton, LS per duration, etc.). The Proposal should provide proposed cost along with expected quantity of material to be expected during the contract period.

A pre-submission meeting was held on July 8, 2026. Listed below are questions asked during the meeting with answers from SWACO.

Question #3: *Will there be compaction requirements?*

Answer: SWACO intends to handle the material once it is delivered. The Successful Proposer can choose to handle the material but would need to place in lifts and compact. There will be no testing.

Question #4: *What will the site be used for once it reaches grade?*

Answer: That is to be determined but could possibly store a building or equipment.

Question #5: *Will SWACO survey the site?*

Answer: SWACO performs monthly drone surveys of the landfill. The East Borrow Area will be a part of these surveys.

Question #6: *What type of trucks will be allowed to dump?*

Answer: SWACO will permit straight trucks only for the delivery and placement of clean hard fill material. Tractor-trailers will not be permitted.

The deadline for questions relating to this *RFP* is 4:00 p.m., July 17, 2026

Proposals are due no later than 1:30 p.m., July 24, 2026
